

### CHAPTER xxiv.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order under the A.D. 1932. Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1899 relating to Glasgow Corporation.

| 16th June 1932.]

WHEREAS the Provisional Order set forth in the schedule hereunto annexed has been made by one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State under the provisions of the Private Legislation Procedure 62 & 63 Vict (Scotland) Act 1899 as read with the Secretaries of State Act 1926 and it is requisite that the said Order should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:---

# SCHEDULE.

### GLASGOW CORPORATION.

Provisional Order to authorise the Corporation of the city of Glasgow to borrow further moneys for the purposes of their parks tramway and water undertakings to increase the amount which they are authorised to expend on musical entertainments to extend the time for compulsory purchase of lands for the construction of works authorised by the Glasgow Corporation Order 1927 and for other purposes.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Corporation of the city of Glasgow (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation" and "the city" respectively) should be authorised to borrow further moneys for the purposes of the Glasgow Parks Acts 1878 to 1929 the Glasgow Tramways Acts 1905 to 1930 and the Glasgow Water Acts 1855 to 1930:

And whereas by the Glasgow Corporation (General Powers) Act 1896 the Corporation were authorised to provide music in public parks and other places within the city or under their control beyond the city and for that purpose to expend annually a sum not exceeding two thousand five hundred pounds and by section 19 (Increase of amount for music in parks) of the Glasgow Corporation Order 1912 the amount to be so expended was increased to four thousand pounds annually and it is expedient that the amount so authorised to be expended should be increased:

And whereas it is expedient that the time limited by section 43 (Period for compulsory purchase) of the Glasgow Corporation Order 1927 for the compulsory purchase of lands for the construction of the bridge over the river Clyde in the city and works connected therewith authorised by that Order should be extended:

And whereas the Corporation make payments from the revenues of their electricity gas markets tramway and water undertakings to hospitals infirmaries convalescent homes nursing associations and other charitable institu- A.D. 1932. tions or in supplement of the contributions of their employees to the same and it is expedient that such payments should be continued and regulated as in this Order provided:

And whereas the assessments for the costs and expenses incurred in connection with the valuation of lands registration of voters and election of town councillors have hitherto been levied in the city on the basis of the actual expenditure incurred in the year previous to the assessment and it is expedient that such assessments should after the fifteenth day of May one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three be levied on the basis of the expenditure estimated to be incurred in the year of assessment:

And whereas it is expedient that the other powers mentioned in this Order should be conferred on the Corporation:

And whereas the purposes aforesaid cannot be effected without an Order confirmed by Parliament under the provisions of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act 1899:

Now therefore in pursuance of the powers contained in the last-mentioned Act as read with the Secretaries of State Act 1926 the Secretary of State orders as follows:—

This Order and the Glasgow Water Acts 1855 to 1930 may be cited together as the Glasgow Water Acts 1855 to 1932.

This Order and the Glasgow Corporation Acts 1855 to 1930 may be cited together as the Glasgow Corporation Acts 1855 to 1932.

Interpretation.

- 2. The following words and expressions in this Order have unless there be something in the subject or context repugnant to such construction the meanings hereby assigned to them (that is to say):—
  - "City" means the city and royal burgh of Glasgow;
  - "Corporation" means the Corporation of the city of Glasgow;
  - "Electricity Acts" means the Glasgow Electric Lighting Acts 1890 to 1930;
  - "Loans Acts" means the Glasgow Loans Acts 1883 to 1930;
  - "Electricity gas markets tramway and water undertakings" means the undertakings of the Corporation authorised by the Electricity Acts the Gas Acts the Markets Acts the Tramways Acts and the Water Acts respectively;
  - "Gas Acts" means the Glasgow Gas Acts 1910 to 1927;
  - "Markets Acts" means the Glasgow Markets Acts 1865 to 1929;
  - "Parks Acts" means the Glasgow Parks Acts 1878 to 1929;
- "Tramways Acts" means the Glasgow Tramways Acts 1905 to 1930;

- "Tramway undertaking" means the undertaking A.D. 1932. authorised by the Tramways Acts;
- "Water Acts" means the Glasgow Water Acts 1855 to 1930.
- 3. The Corporation may for the purpose of carrying Borrowing out the powers conferred upon them by the Parks Acts for parks borrow any sums of money not exceeding in the whole purposes. the sum of one hundred thousand pounds in addition to the sum of one million nine hundred and fifty thousand nine hundred and seventy-eight pounds six shillings and three pence authorised to be borrowed by the Parks Acts and they may again borrow any part of the said sum of one hundred thousand pounds which may have been repaid by them otherwise than by the application of moneys received for lands and properties sold by them and by sinking fund provided by the Parks Acts and this Order and any money so borrowed by them shall be deemed to have been borrowed under the powers and for the purposes of the Parks Acts and this Order and shall form part of the moneys authorised to be borrowed under the Parks Acts and this Order and the maximum amount which may be borrowed under the Parks Acts is hereby increased accordingly.
- 4. The Corporation shall during the year ending Sinking the thirty-first day of May one thousand nine hundred fund for and thirty-three and annually thereafter set apart as a parks sinking fund and pay into the loans fund provided by purposes. the Loans Acts such sum as will secure that the amount from time to time borrowed by them under the immediately preceding section of this Order and not paid off by other means than by sinking fund shall be repaid within a period not exceeding sixty years from the date of such borrowing and they shall apply such sinking fund in paying off the principal sums so borrowed.

5.—(1) The Corporation may borrow for the purposes Borrowing of the powers conferred upon them by the Tramways for tram-Acts and in the manner authorised by and subject to the way purprovisions with respect to the borrowing of money and the repayment thereof by means of a sinking fund of the Glasgow Corporation (Tramways Consolidation) Order 1905 any sum of money not exceeding five hundred thousand pounds in addition to (a) the sum of eight million one hundred and ninety-one thousand nine

- A.D. 1932. hundred and eighty-five pounds authorised to be borrowed by the Tramways Acts and (b) the sum of seventy-one thousand two hundred and eighty-one pounds nine shillings and nine pence authorised to be borrowed by the Govan Burgh (Tramways) Act 1893 (the tramways) belonging to the former burgh of Govan having been vested in the Corporation by the Glasgow Boundaries Act 1912) and if after having borrowed the said sum hereby authorised or any part thereof the Corporation pay off the same by other means than by sinking fund they may reborrow the same.
  - (2) The amount borrowed by the Corporation for the purposes of the tramway undertaking whether in exercise of their powers under the Tramways Acts and this Order or at common law shall not exceed in amount the total sum they are authorised to borrow by the Tramways Acts and this Order.

Borrowing for water purposes.

6. The Corporation may borrow for the purpose of carrying out the powers conferred upon them by the Water Acts any sum of money not exceeding two hundred and fifty thousand pounds in addition to the sum of five million two hundred thousand pounds authorised to be borrowed by the Water Acts and they may again borrow any sums which may have been repaid by them otherwise than by the application of money received for lands and properties sold by them and by sinking fund provided by the Water Acts and this Order and any moneys so borrowed by them shall be deemed to have been borrowed under the powers and for the purposes of the Water Acts and this Order and shall form part of the moneys authorised to be borrowed under the Water Acts and this Order and the maximum amount which may be borrowed under the Water Acts is hereby increased accordingly.

Sinking fund for water purposes.

7. The Corporation shall annually set apart as a sinking fund and pay into the loans fund provided by the Loans Acts not less than one-sixtieth of the amount from time to time borrowed by them under the immediately preceding section of this Order and not paid off by other means than such sinking fund and they shall apply such sinking fund in paying off the principal sums so borrowed Provided that the provisions of section 23 (Provision as to future sinking fund) of the Glasgow Water Act 1912 shall apply to the moneys so borrowed.

8. Section 14 (Corporation may provide music in parks &c.) of the Glasgow Corporation (General Powers) Act 1896 as amended by section 19 (Increase of amount for music in parks) of the Glasgow Corporation Order 1912 shall be read and construed as if the sum thereby in parks. authorised to be expended annually were six thousand pounds in lieu of four thousand pounds.

Increase of amount for music

9. The time limited by section 43 (Period for Extension compulsory purchase) of the Glasgow Corporation Order of time 1927 for the compulsory purchase of lands for the for comconstruction of the bridge over the river Clyde at Finniespurchase ton in the city and works connected therewith authorised of lands by that Order is hereby extended until the thirty-first for bridge. day of October one thousand nine hundred and thirtyseven.

10.—(1) The Corporation may from time to time Payments make reasonable payments or contributions from the to charitrevenues of their electricity gas markets tramway and able instiwater undertakings respectively to and for the purposes of tutions. any hospital infirmary convalescent home nursing association or other charitable institution mainly supported by voluntary contributions and may also from such revenues supplement any contributions made to any such hospital infirmary home association or institution by their employees in such undertakings Provided that the expenditure so incurred together with any payments made by the Corporation under section 16 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1929 shall not exceed in any year the sum referred to in that section.

- (2) The powers conferred by this section shall be in addition to and not in substitution of any existing powers of the Corporation to make contributions to hospitals infirmaries convalescent homes nursing associations and other charitable institutions mainly supported by voluntary contributions.

A.D. 1932. previous to the assessment and it is expedient that such assessments should after the fifteenth day of May one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three be levied on the basis of the expenditure estimated to be incurred in each year of assessment be it enacted that after the fifteenth day of May one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three the assessments for such costs and expenses shall be levied upon the basis of an estimate of the expenditure for such purposes in each such year Provided that the costs and expenses incurred for such purposes in the year ending the fifteenth day of May one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three shall also be paid out of the assessment authorised for such purposes but may be assessed for over such number of years not exceeding five as the Corporation may determine and the Corporation may borrow such sums of money as may be required to pay the said costs and expenses incurred in the said year ending the fifteenth day of May one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three.

Costs of Order.

12. All costs charges and expenses of and incident to the preparing for obtaining and confirming of this Order or otherwise in relation thereto shall be paid by the Corporation and may be allocated by them amongst such of the departments of the Corporation as they may deem expedient and if paid out of borrowed moneys shall be repaid out of revenue within five years from the date of the passing of the Act confirming this Order.

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
