## CHAPTER xxvii.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders of A.D. 1932. the Minister of Health relating to Derby and Stalybridge Hyde Mossley and Dukinfield Tramways and Electricity Board.

[16th June 1932.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health 38 & 39 Vict. Act 1875 the Minister of Health has made certain c. 55. provisional orders which need confirmation by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

- 1. The orders of the Minister of Health which are Orders in set out in the schedule to this Act are hereby confirmed schedule and shall have full validity and force.
- 2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Short title. Provisional Orders Confirmation (Derby and Stalybridge Hyde Mossley and Dukinfield Tramways and Electricity Board) Act 1932.

## SCHEDULE.

## BOROUGH OF DERBY.

Derby Order. Provisional Order altering the Derby Corporation Act 1929.

WHEREAS the borough of Derby is an urban district of which the mayor aldermen and burgesses acting by the council are the urban authority for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875 and the Derby Corporation Act 1929 is in force in the borough;

And whereas section 5 of the local Act authorised the Derby Corporation to enter on take and use certain lands shown on the deposited plans and described in the deposited book of reference for the several purposes mentioned in the said section 5 and by section 7 of that Act a period of three years from the thirty-first day of October nineteen hundred and twenty-nine was limited for the exercise of the powers of the Derby Corporation for the compulsory purchase of the said lands;

And whereas the Derby Corporation have applied to the Minister of Health for the issue of a provisional order to amend the local Act in the manner following:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

Short title and commencement. 1. This order may be cited as the Derby Order 1932 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Interpretation.

- 2. In this order unless the context otherwise requires—
  - "The Derby Corporation" means the mayor aldermen and burgesses of the borough of Derby acting by the council;
  - "The local Act" means the Derby Corporation Act 1929;
  - "The lands numbered 771 and 775" means the lands so numbered on the deposited plans and in the deposited book of reference referred to in the local Act.

Extension of time for completion of works.

3. Section 7 of the local Act except so far as it relates to the lands numbered 771 and 775 shall have effect as if the words "five years" had been inserted therein instead of the words "three years." Provisional Order altering a local Act.

And whereas by section 25 of the local Act provision is made for the appointment of auditors to audit the accounts of the board;

And whereas by section 83 of the local Act section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 which relates to the granting of provisional orders for the repeal alteration or amendment of local Acts extends and applies to the board as if they were a local authority within the meaning of that section;

And whereas the board have applied to the Minister of Health for the issue of a provisional order amending the local Act in the manner following:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 as applied by section 83 of the Stalybridge Hyde Mossley and Dukinfield Tramways and Electricity Board Act 1901 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Stalybridge Hyde Mossley Short title and Dukinfield Tramways and Electricity Board Order 1932 and and comshall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament mencement. confirming it.

2. Section 25 of the Stalybridge Hyde Mossley and Dukinfield Tramways and Electricity Board Act 1901 shall be amended as follows:—

Amendment of section 25 of local Act.

In subsection (1) of that section the words "one or more" shall be substituted for the word "two".
