



CHAPTER lvi.

An Act to confirm a Scheme of the Charity Commissioners A.D. 1916.
for the application or management of the Charity con-
sisting of the Clear Proceeds of Sale of the Bethel
Baptist Chapel and School in Infirmary Street in the
City of Bradford. [18th December 1916.]

WHEREAS the Charity Commissioners in their report to His Majesty of their proceedings during the year one thousand nine hundred and thirteen reported that they had approved and certified a scheme for the application or management of the charity consisting of the clear proceeds of sale of the Bethel Baptist Chapel and School in Infirmary Street in the city of Bradford comprised in an indenture dated the twenty-ninth April one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two and the scheme is set out in an appendix to the said report:

And whereas it is expedient that the said scheme as the same with certain modifications thereof is fully set out and defined in the schedule to this Act should be confirmed:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The said scheme is hereby confirmed Provided always Confirmation
of scheme.
that nothing in this Act or in the said scheme shall be held to interfere with the ordinary jurisdiction over endowed charities now exerciseable or hereafter to become exerciseable by the High Court of Justice and the Charity Commissioners.

2. This Act may be cited as the Bradford (Infirmary Short title.
Street) Baptist Chapel Scheme Confirmation Act 1916.

SCHEDULE.

*Scheme for the application or management of the Charity
consisting of the Clear Proceeds of Sale of the
Bethel Baptist Chapel and School in Infirmery Street in the
City of Bradford.*

1. The above-mentioned proceeds of sale shall be applied by the Trustees thereof in conformity with the provisions herein-after contained.

2. The Trustees may out of the said proceeds pay a sum not exceeding 100*l.* to the treasurer for the time being of Rawdon College near Leeds for the purposes of that college.

3. Subject as aforesaid the said proceeds shall be paid to the Trustees for the time being of the site for a chapel in Rhine Street Paley Road in the city of Bradford comprised in an indenture dated the twelfth December one thousand nine hundred and twelve to be applied towards defraying the cost of building the chapel erected or about to be erected on that site.

4. The Charity Commissioners may from time to time in the exercise of their ordinary jurisdiction establish schemes for the alteration of any of the provisions of this scheme as if those provisions had been made by the founder in the case of a charity having a founder.

5. Any question as to the construction of this scheme or as to the regularity or the validity of any acts done or about to be done under this scheme shall be determined conclusively by the Charity Commissioners upon such application made to them for the purpose as they think sufficient.
