



CHAPTER xxviii.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Minister of Health relating to the county borough of Huddersfield. [30th July 1948.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act 1875 the Minister of Health has made a Provisional Order which needs confirmation by Parliament :

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. The Order of the Minister of Health which is set out in the schedule to this Act is hereby confirmed and shall have full validity and force. confirmed.

2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Order Confirmation (Huddersfield) Act 1948. Short title.

COUNTY BOROUGH OF HUDDERSFIELD.

*Provisional Order for partially repealing certain local

WHEREAS the mayor aldermen and burgesses of the county borough of Huddersfield acting by the council (in this Order called "the Corporation") propose to make byelaws under the Public Health Act 1936 with respect to buildings :

And whereas the proposed byelaws will deal with the same subject-matter as certain provisions of the local Acts and Provisional Order specified in the First Schedule to this Order which are now in force in the said county borough

And whereas the Corporation have applied to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order partially to repeal the local Acts and Provisional Order in the manner following :

Now therefore the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers given to him by sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows :—

Repeal of provisions of local Acts and Provisional Order.

1. The provisions of the local Acts and Provisional Order specified in the Second Schedule to this Order shall to the extent therein specified be repealed on the date on which byelaws made by the Corporation under the Public Health Act 1936 with respect to buildings come into operation.

Short title.

2. This Order may be cited as the Huddersfield Order 1948.
