CHAPTER xxx.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Minister of Health relating to the county borough of Northampton.

[30th July 1948.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act 38 & 39 Vict. 1875 the Minister of Health has made a Provisional Order c. 55. which needs confirmation by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

- 1. The Order of the Minister of Health which is set out in the Order in schedule to this Act is hereby confirmed and shall have full schedule confirmed. validity and force.
- 2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Short title. Order Confirmation (Northampton) Act 1948.

SCHEDULE.

COUNTY BOROUGH OF NORTHAMPTON.

Provisional Order altering and partially repealing a local Act.

WHEREAS the mayor aldermen and burgesses of the county borough of Northampton acting by the council (in this Order called "the Corporation") are the local authority for the purposes of the Public Health Act 1875:

33 & 34 Vict. c. xlv. And whereas the corporation maintain a cattle market in the said county borough under the Northampton Corporation Markets and Fairs Act 1870 (in this Order called "the local Act")

And whereas by sections 12 and 14 of the local Act the Corporation are empowered from time to time to demand and take with respect to the purposes specified in the said sections relating to any market or fair provided under the local Act any tolls and charges not exceeding the several tolls and charges specified in the second and fourth schedules to the local Act and the Corporation are desirous of substituting new tolls and charges for the tolls and charges specified as aforesaid:

And whereas the Corporation have applied to the Minister of Health (in this Order called "the Minister") for the issue of a Provisional Order to alter and partially repeal the local Act for the purposes aforesaid:

Now therefore the Minister in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 303 of the Public Health Act 1875 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

Short title and commencement.

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Northampton Order 1948 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.
- (2) The local Act and this Order may be cited together as the Northampton Markets Act and Order 1870 and 1948.

Interpretation.

2. In this Order unless the context otherwise requires the expression "the markets undertaking" means the markets undertaking of the Corporation.

Market tolls.

3. For the second and fourth schedules to the local Act there shall be substituted respectively Schedules A and B to this Order and sections 12 and 14 of the local Act shall be read and have effect accordingly.

Alteration of tolls.

4. The Corporation may with the sanction of the Secretary of States from time to time alter or add to the tolls and charges mentioned in the schedules to the local Act as amended by this Order and any

such altered tolls and charges shall as from the date on which they come into operation be substituted for the corresponding tolls and charges payable under the said schedules respectively.

- 5. The Corporation without prejudice to any other powers conferred Further powers upon them by the local Act or by any other enactment may from as to markets. time to time—
 - (I) alter the places at which the markets of the corporation respectively are or may be held;

(2) establish and hold new markets and discontinue the whole or any part of any existing or new markets;

(3) enlarge or improve any market provided under the local Act as amended by this Order;

- (4) erect or provide offices shops catering establishments stores warehouses and other tenements or buildings for the purposes of or in connection with any of their markets and the markets undertaking.
- 6. The Corporation may grant leases (with the right if they think Power to grant fit of assigning the same with their consent) of the market market leases. houses market places places for fairs weighing houses weighing places and weighing machines from time to time provided by the Corporation or any of them and the tolls or any of them and any of the stalls standing places benches grounds spaces and other conveniences in their markets or in any market house or market place for the time being provided by them to any person for any period not exceeding seven years and may grant leases (with a similar right) of any office shop catering establishment store warehouse tenement cellar or building situate in any of their markets or forming part of or acquired or erected in connection with the markets undertaking including any premises not used for the time being in connection with the markets undertaking to any person for such period as the Corporation may think fit.
- 7. The undermentioned sections of the local Act are hereby Partial repeal of local Act. repealed: —

Section 8 (Notice to be given of taking houses of the labouring classes);

Section 27 (Power to let shops stalls &c.);

Section 28 (Power to let tolls of markets &c.);

Section 30 (Evidence of byelaws).

- 8.—(1) In section 12 (Tolls for cattle and horse markets and fairs Amendment of second schedule) of the local Act for the words "cattle or horses" local Act. where they first occur there shall be substituted the words "any animal bird vehicle implement or other article ".
- (2) In section 14 (Weighing and measuring tolls fourth schedule) of the local Act for the word "article" wherever it occurs there shall be substituted the words "animal vehicle or article".
- 9. The Corporation shall have power from time to time to borrow Power to such sums as may be necessary for the purposes of this Order. borrow.
- 10. The Minister may hold any inquiry which he may deem necessary Inquiries and for the purposes of this Order and section 290 of the Local Govern-expenses. ment Act 1933 shall apply accordingly. 23 & 24 Geo. 5. c. 51.
