## CHAPTER x

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order made by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries under the Surrey County Council Act 1936 to amend the Land Drainage (Surrey County Council (Hogsmill River Improvement)) Provisional Order Confirmation Act 1942.  
[12th July 1950.]

**W**HEREAS under the provisions of the Surrey County Council Act 1936 the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order which needs confirmation by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Order of the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries which as amended is set out in the schedule to this Act is hereby confirmed and shall have full validity and force.

2. This Act may be cited as the Land Drainage (Surrey County Council (Hogsmill River Improvement) (Amendment)) Provisional Order Confirmation Act 1950.

## SCHEDULE

### SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL (HOGSMILL RIVER IMPROVEMENT) (AMENDMENT)

*Provisional Order under the Surrey County Council Act 1936 to amend the Land Drainage (Surrey County Council (Hogsmill River Improvement)) Provisional Order Confirmation Act 1942*

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries in pursuance of the powers given to him by section 27 of the Surrey County Council Act 1936 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

Short and collective titles.

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Surrey County Council (Hogsmill River Improvement) (Amendment) Order 1950.

(2) The Surrey County Council Acts and Order 1925 to 1942 and this Order may be cited together as the Surrey County Council Acts and Orders 1925 to 1950.

Commencement of Order.

2. This Order shall come into operation upon the date of the passing of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Interpretation.

3. In this Order—

“The Council” means the county council of the administrative county of Surrey;

“The Order of 1942” means the Surrey County Council (Hogsmill River Improvement) Order 1942 (confirmed by the Land Drainage (Surrey County Council (Hogsmill River Improvement)) Provisional Order Confirmation Act 1942).

Amendment of Order of 1942.

4. The Land Drainage (Surrey County Council (Hogsmill River Improvement)) Provisional Order Confirmation Act 1942 and the Order of 1942 shall have effect as if—

(a) in section 15 of the said Order (which limits the period during which the works authorised by Part II of that Order may be constructed to a period ending with the expiry of five years from the expiry of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Act 1939) the words “the thirty-first day of December nineteen hundred and sixty” had been inserted instead of the words “the date of expiry of five years from the expiry of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Act 1939”;

(b) in section 25 of the said Order (which limits the period during which the powers of the Council for the compulsory purchase of lands under the powers of Part II of that Order may be exercised to a period ending with the expiry of five years from the expiry of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Act 1939) the words “the twenty-second day of February nineteen hundred and fifty-four” had been inserted instead of the words “the date of the expiry of five years from the expiry of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Act 1939”;

(c) in section 29 of the said Order (which provides for contributions by certain local authorities towards the cost of the works authorised by Part II of the Order)—

(i) the following sub-paragraph had been inserted at the end of paragraph (b) of subsection (4):—

“(iv) the sum of two thousand five hundred and forty pounds being the cost of certain works of improvement of a tributary of the river Hogsmill carried out by the mayor aldermen and burgesses of the borough of Epsom and Ewell”;

(ii) in the proviso to paragraph (c) of subsection (4) the words “and the borough of Epsom and Ewell” had been inserted after the words “the borough of Malden and Coombe” and the words “and two thousand five hundred and forty pounds” had been inserted after the words “three hundred pounds”;

(iii) in the proviso to paragraph (a) of subsection (5) the words “or the borough of Epsom and Ewell” had been inserted after the words “the borough of Malden and Coombe” and the words “and two thousand five hundred and forty pounds” had been inserted after the words “three hundred pounds”;

(d) in the table contained in subsection (1) of section 41 of the said Order (which confers powers of borrowing on the Council) the figures “£287,000” and “£39,000” had been inserted instead of the figures “£164,780” and “£25,000” respectively and as if at the end of the said table the following had been inserted:—

“(d) the payment of the costs charges and expenses referred to in section 5 (Costs of Order) of the Surrey County Council (Hogsmill River Improvement) (Amendment) Order 1950.”	“The sum requisite.”	“Five years from the commencement of the said Order of 1950.”

(e) in section 42 of the said Order (which confers powers of borrowing upon the local authorities mentioned in the first column of the table in subsection (1) of that section) the figures “£70,179” “£7,582” “£21,603” and “£63,483” had been inserted instead of the figures “£40,489” “£5,264” “£13,583” and “£35,436” respectively.

5.—(1) If any person being the owner or lessee of any land which may be acquired compulsorily under the Order of 1942 shall desire that any such land or his interest therein shall be acquired as soon as may be and shall give notice in writing to the Council of such desire the Council within a period of three

months after the receipt of such notice shall either enter into an effective contract with such person for the acquisition of such land or his interest therein by agreement or serve a notice to treat for the compulsory acquisition thereof or shall intimate their intention not to proceed with the purchase of such land.

(2) In any case in which the Council notify their intention not to proceed with the purchase of any land the powers conferred by the Order of 1942 for the compulsory purchase of such land shall cease.

Costs of Order.

6. All costs charges and expenses of and incidental to the preparing applying for obtaining and confirming of this Order or otherwise incurred in relation thereto as taxed by the taxing officer of one of the Houses of Parliament shall be paid by the Council out of the county fund or out of moneys to be borrowed under the Order of 1942 as amended by this Order and shall for the purposes of section 29 (Contributions by certain authorities) of that Order as amended by this Order be deemed to form part of the expenses incurred by the Council in the execution of the works authorised by Part II (Rivers and streams) of that Order.
