



CHAPTER viii

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order of the Minister of Health relating to the Colne Valley Sewerage Board.
[12th July 1950.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Public Health Act 38 & 39 Vict. 1875 the Minister of Health has made a Provisional Order c. 55. which needs confirmation by Parliament :

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The order of the Minister of Health which is set out in the Order in schedule to this Act is hereby confirmed and shall have full validity and force. schedule confirmed.
2. This Act may be cited as the Ministry of Health Provisional Order Confirmation (Colne Valley Sewerage Board) Act 1950. Short title.

COLNE VALLEY SEWERAGE BOARD

WHEREAS by the Hertfordshire County Council (Colne Valley Sewerage &c.) Act 1937 (in this Order called "the Act of 1937") the Colne Valley Sewerage Board (in this Order called "the Board") consisting of members appointed by the council of the administrative county of Hertford the councils of the city of St. Alban and of the boroughs of Hemel Hempstead and Watford the urban district councils of Bushey Chorleywood Potters Bar and Rickmansworth and the rural district councils of Barnet Hatfield Hemel Hempstead St. Albans and Watford was constituted for the purposes (inter alia) of constructing main sewers and other works and acquiring lands for the disposal of sewage:

And whereas by subsection (1) of section 118 (As to alteration or repeal of Act) of the Act of 1937 it is provided that the Minister of Health may on the application of the Board by Provisional Order alter amend or partially repeal any provisions of the said Act other than section 45 (Discharge of effluent into river Colne) section 46 (Purity of effluent) and section 47 (Penalty for pollution) and any provisions comprised in Part VIII of the said Act:

And whereas the Board in pursuance of subsection (1) of section 118 of the Act of 1937 have made application to the Minister of Health for a Provisional Order to alter or amend the provisions of the Act of 1937 in the manner following:

Now therefore the Minister of Health in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the said subsection (1) of section 118 of the Act of 1937 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

Short title and commencement.

1. This Order may be cited as the Colne Valley Sewerage Order 1950 and shall come into operation on the date of the Act of Parliament confirming it.

Interpretation.

2. In this Order unless the context otherwise requires words and expressions to which meanings are assigned by section 4 (Interpretation) of the Act of 1937 shall have the same respective meanings and "the Order of 1947" means the Colne Valley Sewerage (Extension of Time) Order 1947.

Expenses of public entertainment.

3. The Board may pay reasonable expenses incurred in providing entertainment for persons visiting the Board or its undertaking or any part thereof on the invitation of the Board.

4. The Board may pay to the chairman of the Board for the purpose of enabling him to meet the expenses of his office such allowance as the Board may think reasonable.

5. The Act of 1937 as amended by the Order of 1947 shall be further amended as follows:—

Amendment of
Act of 1937.

(a) in section 26 (which provides that the power to construct the works authorised by section 19 of the said Act shall expire on the 1st October 1950) for the words "first day of October nineteen hundred and fifty" there shall be substituted the words "first day of October nineteen hundred and fifty-five";

(b) in paragraph 1 of the Second Schedule (which provides that members of the Board shall normally come into office on the 1st April next after their appointment) for the words "first day of April" where they occur the second time there shall be substituted the words "first day of June";

(c) in paragraph 6 of the Second Schedule (which so far as is material provides that the annual meeting of the Board shall be held in every year as soon as is convenient after the 16th April) for the words "sixteenth day of April" there shall be substituted the words "sixteenth day of June".
