



CHAPTER ix.

An Act to confirm a Provisional Order made under section one of the Electricity (Supply) Act 1922 relating to the North West Midlands Joint Electricity Authority. [13th July 1944.]

WHEREAS under the provisions of section one of the ^{12 & 13 Geo. 5.} Electricity (Supply) Act 1922 the Minister of Fuel and ^{c. 46.} Power has confirmed a Provisional Order made by the Electricity Commissioners which needs confirmation by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Order set out in the schedule to this Act is hereby ^{Order in} confirmed and shall have full validity and force: ^{schedule} confirmed.
2. This Act may be cited as the North West Midlands Joint ^{Short title.} Electricity Authority Order Confirmation Act 1944.

SCHEDULE.

NORTH WEST MIDLANDS JOINT ELECTRICITY AUTHORITY.

Provisional Order made by the Electricity Commissioners and confirmed by the Minister of Fuel and Power under the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1936 for amending the North West Midlands Joint Electricity Authority (Increase of Borrowing Powers) Order 1939 as amended by the North West Midlands Electricity District (Meaford Generating Station) Special Order 1941.

Short and collective titles.

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the North West Midlands Joint Electricity Authority (Increase of Borrowing Powers) Order 1944.

(2) The North West Midlands Electricity District Orders 1928 to 1941 and this Order may be cited together as the North West Midlands Electricity District Orders 1928 to 1944.

Amendment of section 2 of North West Midlands Joint Electricity Authority (Increase of Borrowing Powers) Order 1939.
Costs of Order.

2. Section 2 (Maximum amount which may be borrowed by North West Midlands Joint Electricity Authority) of the North West Midlands Joint Electricity Authority (Increase of Borrowing Powers) Order 1939 as amended by section 11 (Amendment of section 2 of Order of 1939) of the North West Midlands Electricity District (Meaford Generating Station) Special Order 1941 shall have effect as if the words "six years" were inserted in paragraph (b) thereof instead of the words "three years".

3. All costs charges and expenses preliminary to and of and incidental to the preparing applying for and obtaining of this Order and otherwise incurred in reference thereto as taxed by the taxing officer of the House of Lords or of the House of Commons shall be paid by the North West Midlands Joint Electricity Authority out of moneys to be borrowed by the Authority under the North West Midlands Electricity District Orders 1928 to 1941 and this Order but may in the first instance be paid by the Authority as part of their administrative expenses and moneys so paid shall be recouped by and charged to the moneys to be borrowed under the said Orders.

Commencement of Order.

4. This Order shall come into force upon the day on which the Act confirming this Order is passed and that day shall be the commencement of this Order.
