III Appointment of Steward of Wirksworth Barmote Court.

From and after the passing of this Act it shall be lawful for the Queen and Her Successors to nominate and appoint from Time to Time, by Letters Patent under the Seal of the Duchy of *Lancaster*; a fit and proper Person, being a Barrister-at-Law of Five Years standing, or a Member of One of the Inns at Court who has practised as a Special Pleader for Ten Years, or [^{F1}a solicitor of the Supreme Court] of Seven Years standing, to be and to be called the “Steward of the *Wirksworth* Barmote Courts,” and such Steward shall hold his Office during the Will and Pleasure of the Queen and Her Successors.
