

Tweed Fisheries Amendment Act 1859

1859 CHAPTER lxx 22 and 23 Vict

XVI Cleeks not to be used in landing Fish.

Every Person who shall between the Fifteenth Day of *September* in any Year and the First Day of *May* in the Year following, in fishing with a Rod and Line, use any Cleek or Instrument for landing Fish other than a Landing Net, shall be liable to a Penalty not exceeding [FIF2£25][F2level 1 on the standard scale].
