## *Cap. cxciv.*

An Act to rectify a Mistake in an Act of the present Session, “for incorporating and granting other Powers to ‘The Land Loan and Enfranchisement Company.’” [13th August 1860.]

**W**HEREAS by the Fifty-third Section of the above-mentioned 23 & 24 Vict. c. clxix.  
Act it is, among other things, enacted as follows: “The Com-  
pany may, with the Approval of the Commissioners, to be  
“ signified by an Endorsement under their Seal, and the Hands of Two  
“ of them, upon the Charges to be affected thereby, indicating that such  
“ Charges respectively have been appropriated as herein-after mentioned,  
“ appropriate or set apart any Charge or Charges payable to the Com-  
“ pany hereunder, and in the Case of the Forty-fourth Section hereof  
“ certified as therein mentioned as the Fund for the Payment of a Series  
“ of Mortgage Debentures to be founded upon and secured by such  
“ appropriated Charge or Charges:” And whereas upon the Third Read-  
ing of the Bill in the House of Lords the Sections Forty-two and Forty-  
three of the Bill as it had passed through the Committee of that Right  
Honourable House were struck out, and the Alteration ought to have  
been at the same Time made of the Number “Forty-fourth” to the  
Number “Forty-second,” and it is essential to the due Operation of  
the Fifty-third Section of the Act that the said Error should be cor-

rected: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, as follows:

the Word  
"Forty-  
fourth" to  
read "Forty-  
second."

I. The Fifty-third Section of the said Act shall be read as though the Words "Forty-second" were inserted therein instead of the Words "Forty-fourth," and the Section referred to shall be deemed to be the Forty-second Section of the same Act.
