

CHAP. lvii.

An Act to confirm a scheme under "The Metropolitan A.D. 1871. Commons Act, 1866," relating to Blackheath.

[29th June 1871.]

TATHEREAS the Inclosure Commissioners for England and Wales have, in pursuance of "The Metropolitan Commons Act, 29 & 30 Vict. 1866," duly certified a scheme for the establishment of local manage- c. 122. ment with respect to Blackheath, situate in the parishes of Greenwich and Lewisham, in the county of Kent, and it is by the said Act provided that no such scheme shall have any operation until such scheme shall have been confirmed by Parliament, and it is expedient that the said scheme should be so confirmed, subject to the modifications herein-after mentioned:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. " clause 6 of the Metropolitan Commons Act, 1866, inasmuch as "the improvement of the heath and the prevention of nuisances . "thereon and other purposes of a like nature cannot be carried out "without in some small degree interfering with such rights, but " such interference will be beneficial to such rights and the persons "entitled thereto respectively, and no such rights are taken away " or injuriously affected," the lords of the manors of Lewisham and East Greenwich having consented to such modification, and that the said scheme so modified be hereby confirmed, and from and after the passing of this Act shall be deemed to be a Public General
