

## CHAPTER clxi.

An Act to regulate the Sittings of the Quarter Sessions A.D. 1879. Court of the Borough of Cork. [21st July 1879.]

HEREAS the present fortnightly sittings of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the borough of Cork are attended with great loss and inconvenience to the jurors of the said borough and are unnecessary:

And whereas since the union of the offices of recorder of Cork and county court judge of the east riding of Cork such sittings have become inexpedient, and are incapable of being carried into effect without a serious impediment and delay to the proper administration of justice in the sessions towns of said east riding, and it is therefore expedient to repeal the enactment regulating the 15 & 16 Vict. present sittings of the said borough quarter sessions, and to provide c. exliii. for the holding thereof in manner herein-after mentioned:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited for any purpose as the Cork Borough Short title. Court Amendment Act, 1879.

So much of the Act passed in the session of Parliament held Repeal of in the fifteenth and sixteenth years of Her present Majesty, chapter 15 & 16 Vict. one hundred and forty-three, intituled "The Cork Improvement Act, s. 105. 1852," as requires that the recorder shall hold a general quarter sessions of the peace for the borough, or an adjournment thereof, once at least in every fortnight in each and every year, is hereby repealed, and instead thereof the one hundred and sixty-eighth 3 & 4 Vict. section of the Act of the session of Parliament held in the third and fourth years of the reign of Her present Majesty, chapter one hundred and eight, intituled "An Act for the regulation of Cork Quar-[Local.-161.]
