CHAPTER lxxxii.

An Act to confirm an Order of the Local Government Board A.D. 1887. under the provisions of the Divided Parishes and Poor Law Amendment Act, 1876, as amended and extended by the Poor Law Act, 1879, relating to the Parishes of Aldington, Saint Leonard, Hythe, and West Hythe.

[5th July 1887.]

TATHEREAS the Local Government Board have made the Order set forth in the schedule hereto, under the provisions of the 39 & 40 Vict. Divided Parishes and Poor Law Amendment Act, 1876, as amended c. 61.

42 & 43 Vict. and extended by the Poor Law Act, 1879:

c. 54.

And whereas the said Order has become provisional, and it is requisite that the same should be confirmed by Parliament:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1. The Order set out in the schedule hereto shall be and the The Order same is hereby confirmed, and shall come into operation from and in schedule after the twenty-fifth day of March next ensuing the date of this Act.
- 2. This Act may be cited as the Local Government Board's Short title of the Act. Provisional Order Confirmation (Poor Law) (No. 3) Act, 1887.

EAST ASHFORD, ELHAM, AND ROMNEY MARSH UNIONS.

To the Guardians of the Poor of the East Ashford, Elham, and Romney Marsh Unions, in the County of Kent; —

To the Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the Parish of Aldington, in the said East Ashford Union, of the Parish of Saint Leonard, Hythe, in the said Elham Union, and of the Parish of West Hythe, in the said Romney Marsh Union;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by the provisions of the Divided Parishes and Poor Law Amendment Act, 1876, as amended and extended by the Poor Law Act, 1879, We, the Local Government Board, are empowered to deal by Order with parts of divided Parishes;

And whereas the said Parish of Aldington is included in the said East Ashford Union, the said Parish of Saint Leonard, Hythe, is included in the said Elham Union, and the said Parish of West Hythe is included in the said Romney Marsh Union;

And whereas the said Parishes of Aldington and West Hythe are divided Parishes within the meaning of the said Acts, a part of each of such Parishes being situate on one side while the residue in each case is situate on the other side of the boundary of the Municipal Borough of Hythe;

And whereas a proposal having been made that the part of each of the said Parishes of Aldington and West Hythe which is included in the said Municipal Borough should be separated from the Parish to which it belongs, and be amalgamated with the said Parish of Saint Leonard, Hythe, or be otherwise dealt with under the said Acts, We caused local Inquiry to be held, after notice duly given as required by the Act first above-mentioned, and report has been made to Us thereon;

And whereas it is expedient that the part of each of the said Parishes of Aldington and West Hythe which is included in the said Municipal Borough should be separated from the Parish to which it belongs, and that the said parts should be united, and that the parts so united should be amalgamated with the adjoining Parish of Saint Leonard, Hythe; and the Education Department have given their sanction thereto, in accordance with Section 4 of the Act first above-mentioned, so far as such arrangement may affect the constitution of any School District:

Now therefore, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by the Statutes in that behalf, We hereby Order as follows:—

Article I.—All those parts of the said Parishes of Aldington and West Hythe which are included in the said Muncipal Borough of Hythe shall cease to be parts of those Parishes respectively, and shall be united, and the parts so united shall be amalgamated with the said Parish of Saint Leonard, Hythe.

Article II.—This Order shall take effect on the Twenty-fourth day of March, One thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, unless the same should in the meantime become Provisional in pursuance of Section 2 of the said Divided Parishes and Poor Law Amendment Act, 1876.

Given under the Seal of Office of the Local Government Board, this Thirteenth day of September, in the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-six.
