

An Act to extend the time for constructing the Works of A.D. 1888. the London Sea Water Supply Company.

[24th July 1888.]

WHEREAS by the London Sea Water Supply Act 1881 (hereinafter called "the recited Act") the London Sea Water Supply Company (hereinafter called "the Company") were incorporated and empowered to make and maintain certain conduits reservoirs and works in the parishes of Lancing Bramber and Steyning in the county of Sussex the parish of St. Mary Battersea in the county of Surrey and in the parish of St. Peter and St. Paul Hammersmith in the county of Middlesex:

And whereas the time limited by the recited Act for the construction of the works thereby authorised will expire on the eighteenth day of July one thousand eight hundred and eightyeight and the Company will not have constructed the works within the time so limited:

And whereas it is expedient that further time be granted them for that purpose:

And whereas the purpose aforesaid cannot be attained without the authority of Parliament:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited for all purposes as the London Sea Short title. Water Supply Act 1888.
- 2. Part II. (extension of time) of the Railways Clauses Act 1863 Incorporais incorporated with and forms part of this Act and shall apply as if Part II. of the works authorised by the Act of 1881, were a railway and the Railways Company were a railway company.

Extending limit for completion of works.

3. The time limited by the recited Act for the completion of the works thereby authorised is hereby extended until the eighteenth day of July one thousand eight hundred and ninety and on the expiration of that period the power by the said Act granted to the Company for constructing the said works or otherwise in relation thereto shall cease except as to so much thereof as shall then be completed.

Provisions as to general Railway and Water-works Act.

4. Nothing in this Act contained shall exempt the Company or their works from the provisions of the Railways Clauses Consolidation Act 1845 the Waterworks Clauses Act 1847 and the Waterworks Clauses Act 1863 in so far as they relate to the works of the Company or any general Act hereafter to be passed with respect to waterworks companies.

Costs of Act.

5. All costs charges and expenses of and incident to the preparing for obtaining and passing of this Act or otherwise in relation thereto shall be paid by the Company.
