XXXIV Penalty for Offences against Naval Discipline not particularly mentioned. XXXV Penalty for not sending to the Court of Admiralty all Papers found aboard Prize Ships. Penalty for taking Money or other Effects out of any Prize before the XXXVI same shall be condemned. Penalty for stripping or ill-using Persons taken on board a Prize.
