

CHAP. 18.

An Act to amend the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act. [24th June 1869.]

A.D. 1869.

HEREAS it is expedient that the provisions contained in "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845," should be amended:

Be it therefore enacted and declared by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Where in England, under "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Costs of Act, 1845," or any Act incorporating the same, any question of arbitrations, where sither disputed compensation is determined by arbitration, the costs of party so reand incidental to the arbitration and award shall, if either party quires, to be settled by a so requires, be taxed and settled as between the parties by any one master of of the taxing masters of the Superior Courts of Law; and such Superior Courts. fees may be taken in respect of the taxation as may be fixed in pursuance of the enactments relating to the fees to be demanded and taken in the offices of such masters, and all those enactments, including the enactments relating to the taking of fees by means of stamps, shall extend to the fees in respect of the said taxation.

2. Section thirty-three of the Regulation of Railways Act, Repeal of 1868, is hereby repealed, and any proceedings commenced in pur- 31 & 32 Vict. suance of that section may be continued under this Act as if they had been commenced under it.

3. Where any lands by the special Act authorized to be taken Provision are situate within the city and liberty of Westminster, then, with respecting lands in respect to those lands, in every case in which any question of Westdisputed compensation is required by the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845, or any Act amending the same, to be determined by the verdict of a jury, the high bailiff of the city and liberty of Westminster, or his deputy, shall be deemed to be

This Act may be cited as "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Construction Act, 1869," and shall be construed as one with the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845, and the Lands Clauses Consolidation Acts Amendment Act, 1860, and these Acts and this Act may be cited together as the Lands Clauses Consolidation Acts, 1845, 1860, and 1869.
