



CHAPTER 17.

An Act to amend the House of Commons Costs Taxation A.D. 1879. [3d July 1879.] Act, 1847.

THEREAS it is expedient that the provisions of the House of Commons Costs Taxation Act, 1847, should be extended 10 & 11 Vict. and made applicable to other cases than those mentioned in the c. 69. said Act:

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. All the powers and provisions of the above-recited Act shall Powers of extend and apply to the costs, charges, and expenses of any c. 69. exparliamentary agent, solicitor, or other person in respect to the tended to obtaining or promotion of or opposition to any provisional order or provisional provisional certificate, or any Bill for confirming the same; and other cases. in respect to the promotion of any Bill by any public trustees or commissioners, or by any municipal or other public authority, and in respect to the opposition to any public and general Bill.

2. In case the taxing officer of the House of Commons shall be Taxing requested by one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State officer of House of or by the Local Government Board to tax and settle, or to assist Commons to in taxing and settling, any costs, charges, or expenses incurred in respect of any Bill, or in respect of any provisional order or pro-Bills on revisional certificate, such taxing officer shall thereupon proceed quest from to tax and settle the same, and shall return the same with his authority. opinion thereon to the Secretary of State or to the Local Government Board, as the case may be.
