



CHAPTER 35.

An Act respecting the Representation in the Parliament of A.D. 1886. Canada of Territories which for the time being form part of the Dominion of Canada, but are not included in any [25th June 1886.] Province.

THEREAS it is expedient to empower the Parliament of Canada to provide for the representation in the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, or either of them, of any territory which for the time being forms part of the Dominion of Canada, but is not included in any province:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. The Parliament of Canada may from time to time make pro- Provision by vision for the representation in the Senate and House of Commons Parliament of Canada, or in either of them, of any territories which for the for representime being form part of the Dominion of Canada, but are not tation of included in any province thereof.

2. Any Act passed by the Parliament of Canada before the Effect of passing of this Act for the purpose mentioned in this Act shall, if Acts of Parliament of not disallowed by the Queen, be, and shall be deemed to have been, Canada. valid and effectual from the date at which it received the assent, in Her Majesty's name, of the Governor-General of Canada.

It is hereby declared that any Act passed by the Parliament of Canada, whether before or after the passing of this Act, for the purpose mentioned in this Act or in the British North America Act, 34 & 35 Viet. 1871, has effect, notwithstanding anything in the British North 30 & 31 Vict. America Act, 1867, and the number of Senators or the number c. 3. of Members of the House of Commons specified in the lastmentioned Act is increased by the number of Senators or of

Members, as the case may be, provided by any such Act of the A.D. 1886. Parliament of Canada for the representation of any provinces or territories of Canada.

Short title and construction.

3. This Act may be cited as the British North America Act, 1886.
