



CHAPTER 39.

An Act to amend paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section nineteen of the Welsh Church Act, 1914. A.D. 1938.

[13th July 1938.]

BE it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section nineteen of the Welsh Church Act, 1914 (which made provision, among other things, as to the application by the University of Wales of part of the property referred to in that paragraph for the benefit of the Colleges of the University) shall have effect as if after the word "Monmouthshire" there were therein inserted the words "the University College of Swansea", and as if for the words "one-fourth" there were therein substituted the words "three-sixteenths."

2. This Act may be cited as the Welsh Church (Amendment) Act, 1938, and shall be construed as one with the Welsh Church Acts, 1914 and 1919, and those Acts and this Act may be cited together as the Welsh Church Acts, 1914 to 1938.
