## 1964 CHAPTER 14

### PART IV

#### GENERAL

#### 34 The gazette.

- (1) The Ministers shall from time to time publish a gazette (in this Act referred to as “the gazette”), and shall use the gazette as one of the means of publishing notice of matters to be published under this Act [<sup>F1</sup>or Part I of the Plant Varieties Act 1997].
- (2) It shall be no defence in civil or criminal proceedings to show that at any time a person did not know of an entry in the register under [<sup>F2</sup>section 18 of the Plant Varieties Act 1997], . . . <sup>F3</sup>, if before that time notice of that entry . . . <sup>F3</sup> had been published in the gazette.
