



# Fireworks Act 1964

## 1964 CHAPTER 23

An Act to exempt fireworks consigned for export from the requirements of the Fireworks Act 1951 as to marking. [25th March 1964]

### **1 Exemption of fireworks for export from requirements as to marking.**

Nothing in section 5(1) or (2) of the <sup>M1</sup>Fireworks Act 1951 (which impose requirements as to the marking of fireworks and their containers) shall apply to fireworks consigned from a factory for transmission to a place outside the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man.
