

New Forest Act 1964

1964 CHAPTER 83

14 Expenses.

- (1) The expenses of the Minister under this Act shall be defrayed out of moneys provided by Parliament.
- (2) The expenses of the Forestry Commissioners under this Act shall be defrayed [^{F1}in accordance with section 41 of the Forestry Act 1967].
- (3) Any increase attributable to the provisions of this Act in the sums payable out of moneys provided by Parliament by way of Rate-Deficiency Grant or Exchequer Equalisation Grant under the enactments relating to local government in England and Wales ^{F2}... shall be defrayed out of moneys so provided.
