#### AMENDMENTS NOT AFFECTING THE LAW OF THE GAMBIA

##### *Visiting forces*

- 5 In the <sup>M1</sup>Visiting Forces (British Commonwealth) Act 1933, section 4 (attachment and mutual powers of command) shall apply in relation to forces raised in The Gambia as it applies in relation to forces raised in Dominions within the meaning of the <sup>M2</sup>Statute of Westminster 1931.

- 6 In the <sup>M3</sup>Visiting Forces Act 1952—
- (a) ..... <sup>F1</sup>

- and, until express provision with respect to The Gambia is made by Order in Council under section 8 of that Act (application to visiting forces of law relating to home forces), any such Order for the time being in force shall be deemed to apply to visiting forces of The Gambia.
