CERTIFICATES AS RESPECTS PLANNING PERMISSION AND GRANT OF STATUTORY LICENCES TO ABSTRACT WATER

Procedure on application for certificate

- 7 (1) [^{F1}The Secretary of State]and the planning Minister acting jointly may by regulations contained in a statutory instrument prescribe the manner in which applications are to be made for certificates under this Schedule, and any such regulations may contain such supplemental or incidental provisions as appear to those Ministers to be expedient.
- (2) The regulations may in particular apply with or without modification any of the provisions of a development order under [^{F2}the Town and Country Planning Act 1990] or under [^{F3}the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997]or of regulations made under the ^{M1}Water Resources Act 1963.
