## SCHEDULE

### IMMUNITIES AND PRIVILEGES

#### PART I

##### THE COMMONWEALTH SECRETARIAT

- 1 (1) The Commonwealth Secretariat shall have immunity from suit and legal process except—
- (a) in respect of a civil action for damage alleged to have been caused by a motor vehicle belonging to, or operated on behalf of the Secretariat or in respect of a motor traffic offence involving such a vehicle; <sup>F1</sup>...

- (2) The foregoing sub-paragraph shall not be construed as authorising the enforcement of any judgment or arbitration award by execution on the premises or official archives of the Secretariat.
