SCHEDULE

IMMUNITIES AND PRIVILEGES

PART I

THE COMMONWEALTH SECRETARIAT

- 3 The Commonwealth Secretariat shall be exempt from income tax and the capital gains tax and shall have the like exemption from [^{F1}the general rate][^{F1}any non-domestic rate] as is accorded by law in respect of the premises of the mission of a sending State.
