Valuation and Rating

22 Complaints regarding omissions from the valuation roll.

- (1) Any person interested may complain to the [FIFirst-tier Tribunal for Scotland] for a valuation area (which terms in this section have the same meaning as in the MIValuation and Rating (Scotland) Act 1956) to the effect—
 - [F2(a)] that particular lands and heritages are not included in the valuation roll for that area and that they ought to be so included; [F3 or
 - (b) that lands and heritages consisting of a pitch for a caravan have been treated as part of a single unit of lands and heritages by virtue of section 3(1) of the Rating (Caravan Sites) Act 1976 and ought to be separately entered in such valuation roll;

F4 ...

- (2) After hearing a complaint under this section the [FIFirst-tier Tribunal for Scotland] may dismiss it or may direct that such entry be made in the Valuation roll as respects the lands and heritages concerned as may be specified in the direction.
- (3) A decision made under the last foregoing subsection shall be subject to appeal by way of stated case in the manner provided by section 7 of the M2 Valuation of Lands (Scotland) Amendment Act 1879.
