1968 CHAPTER 41

Supplemental

50 Short title, repeals, commencement and extent.

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Countryside Act 1968.
- (2) The enactments mentioned in Schedule 5 to this Act shall be repealed to the extent specified in the third column of that Schedule.
- (3) This Act shall come into force at the expiration of a period of one month beginning with the date on which it is passed.

- (5) This Act, except subsections (1), (3) ^{F2}... of this section, sections 15, 24, 25, 26, 32, 37, 46(3) and so much of sections 46(1), 48, and 49 as relates to the first-mentioned sections, shall not extend to Scotland, ^{F3}... this Act shall not extend to Northern Ireland.
