### PART II

#### PREVENTION OF PUBLIC DANGER FROM DISUSED TIPS

#### 35 Application to Scotland.

In the application of this Part of this Act in Scotland—

- (a) “the court” means the sheriff, and any application to the sheriff under this Part of this Act shall be disposed of in a summary manner; and
- (b) “mortgagee” means creditor in a heritable security, and “heritable security” has the same meaning as in the <sup>M1</sup>Conveyancing (Scotland) Act 1924 except that it includes a security constituted by ex facie absolute disposition or assignation.
