PART I

REDUCTION OF AGE OF MAJORITY AND RELATED PROVISIONS

- (3) Where for the purpose of obtaining a certificate ^{F3}... for marriage [F4 or marriage schedule] under Part III of the said Act of 1949 a person declares that the consent of any person or persons whose consent to the marriage is required under the said section 3 has been obtained, the superintendent registrar may refuse to issue the certificate ^{F3}... for marriage [F4 or marriage schedule] unless satisfied by the production of written evidence that the consent of that person or of those persons has in fact been obtained.
- (4) In this section any expression which is also used in the said Act of 1949 has the same meaning as in that Act.
