

Local Government (Footpaths and Open Spaces) (Scotland) Act 1970

1970 CHAPTER 28

An Act to confer on local authorities in Scotland power to take over the control and maintenance of certain footpaths, and to construct and maintain certain footpaths; to authorise local authorities in Scotland to acquire or maintain certain open spaces; and for connected purposes. [29th May 1970]
