



# Marriage (Registrar General's Licence) Act 1970

## 1970 CHAPTER 34

### 18 Regulations.

- (1) The Registrar General, with the approval of the [<sup>F1</sup>Secretary of State], may by statutory instrument make regulations prescribing anything which is required in this Act to be prescribed.
- (2) Any power to make regulations shall include power to vary or revoke those regulations.
