# **1970 CHAPTER 45**

## PART I

### PROVISIONS WITH RESPECT TO ANCILLARY AND OTHER RELIEF IN MATRIMONIAL CAUSES AND TO CERTAIN OTHER MATRIMONIAL PROCEEDINGS

Provisions as to variation, discharge and enforcement of certain orders

#### 12 Application of Maintenance Orders Acts to orders under ss. 1, 2, 3 and 6

- (1) Any order made by virtue of section 1, 2, 3 or 6 of this Act or any corresponding enactment of the Parliament of Northern Ireland shall be included among the orders to which section 16 of the Maintenance Orders Act 1950 applies (which section specifies the orders enforceable under Part II of that Act); and any order made by virtue of the said section 1, 2, 3 or 6 shall be a maintenance order within the meaning of the Maintenance Orders Act 1958.
- (2) This section, so far as it affects Part II of the Maintenance Orders Act 1950, shall extend to Scotland and Northern Ireland.
