# 10 Application of certain enactments to liability under sections 2 to [<sup>F1</sup>4A].

For the purposes of the Fatal Accidents Acts 1846 to 1959, the <sup>MI</sup>Law Reform (Contributory Negligence) Act 1945 and [<sup>F2</sup>the Limitation Act 1980] any damage for which a person is liable under sections 2 to [<sup>F3</sup>4A] of this Act shall be treated as due to his fault.
