An Act to make further provision for contributions by local authorities in Wales (including Monmouthshire) towards the expenses of the Welsh National Opera Company. [27th May 1971]

B IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. The power conferred on a local authority by section 132 Contributions of the Local Government Act 1948 to contribute towards the towards expenses of an entertainment held in the area of another authority expenses of shall, in relation to the Welsh National Opera Company, be National exercisable by any local authority in Wales (including Monmouth-Opera shire), whether or not the place in which that Company performs Company. is convenient for residents in their area, and whether or not 1948 c. 26. the other authority consent.
- 2. Any increase attributable to this Act in the sums payable Consequential by way of rate support grant under the enactments relating to increases in local government in England and Wales shall be defrayed out of rate support moneys provided by Parliament.
- 3. This Act may be cited as the Welsh National Opera Company Short title. Act 1971.
