

# Fire Precautions Act 1971 (repealed)

# **1971 CHAPTER 40**

Miscellaneous and general

### 41 Application to premises occupied by U.K. Atomic Energy Authority.

Sections 17, 18, 30, 31 and 36 of this Act shall not apply to any premises occupied by the United Kingdom Atomic Energy Authority, and in the application of other provisions of this Act to any such premises—

- (a) for any reference to the [<sup>f</sup>1fire authority [<sup>F1</sup>fire and rescue authority]] there shall be substituted a reference to a fire inspector or any person authorised by the Secretary of State to act for the purposes of this section; and
- (b) for the reference in section 20(1) to an [<sup>F2</sup>officer of the fire brigade maintained by the fire authority [<sup>F2</sup>employee of the fire and rescue authority]] there shall be substituted a reference to any person.
