



# Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1972

## 1972 CHAPTER 62

### 3 Seizure of milk etc. liable to spread disease.

In section 13 of the <sup>M1</sup> Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1963 (which among other things provides for the seizure and disposal of carcasses and other things including eggs with a view to preventing the spread of certain diseases and for the payment in certain cases of compensation for things seized} after the word “eggs” in subsection (1) there shall be inserted the words “milk, skim milk, whey, buttermilk, cream”.
