



# Administration of Justice Act 1973

## 1973 CHAPTER 15

### PART I

#### JUSTICES OF THE PEACE

1

(1) ..... <sup>F1</sup>

(9) There shall cease to have effect—

- (a) section 1 of the <sup>M1</sup>Metropolitan Police Act 1829 in so far as it regulates the appointment or removal of the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis ; and
- (b) so much of section 2 of the <sup>M2</sup>Metropolitan Police Act 1856 as provides for the Assistant Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis to be justices of the peace ;

and the Commissioner of Police shall be appointed in like manner as Assistant Commissioners are under the said section 2 to be appointed.
