An Act to amend further the Parks Regulation Act 1872.

**1**

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Parks Regulation (Amendment) Act 1974.

- 1 In sections 3, 5, 6, 7 and 8 for the words “park-keeper” or “keeper”, there shall be substituted the words “park constable”.
- 2 After section 3 there shall be inserted the following section:—

**“3A Attestation of park constables.**

Every park constable shall on appointment be attested as a constable by making a declaration before a justice of the peace that he will duly execute the office of constable.”
