- (1) This Act may be cited as the Parks Regulation (Amendment) Act 1974.
- (2) The MIParks Regulation Act 1872 and the M2Parks Regulation (Amendment) Act 1926 and this Act may be cited together as the Parks Regulation Acts 1872 to 1974.
