126 Enforcement of land mortgages.

- [^{F1}(1) A land mortgage securing a regulated agreement [^{F2}or a regulated mortgage contract (within the meaning of the Regulated Activities Order)] is enforceable (so far as provided in relation to the agreement) on an order of the court only.]
