ENFORCEMENT OF ACT

161 Enforcement authorities.

- (1) The following authorities ("enforcement authorities") have a duty to enforce this Act and regulations made under it—
 - (a) the $[^{F1}OFT]$,
 - (b) in Great Britain, the local weights and measures authority,
 - (c) in Northern Ireland, the Department of Commerce for Northern Ireland.
- (2) F2.....
- (3) Every local weights and measures authority shall, whenever the [F1OFT] requires, report to [F3it] in such form and with such particulars as [F3it] requires on the exercise of their functions under this Act.
