1974 CHAPTER 46

Registration of societies and branches

16 Appeals from refusal to register.

[^{F1}(1) If the [^{F2}FCA] refuses to register a branch, the branch may appeal to the High Court or, in the case of a branch whose registered office is to be situated in Scotland, the Court of Session.]

(2) If a refusal to register a ^{F3} . . . branch is overruled on appeal, the [^{F2}FCA] shall give an acknowledgment of registration under [^{F4}section 15A] above to the ^{F3} . . . branch.
