PART III

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURE OF INDUSTRIAL TRIBUNALS

Extended scope of industrial tribunals

[Section 100]

- 16 (1) Tribunals established under section 12 of the Industrial Training Act 1964 shall, by the name of industrial tribunals, continue to exercise the jurisdiction conferred on them by or under that Act, the Redundancy Payments Act 1965, the Docks and Harbours Act 1966, the Selective Employment Payments Act 1966, the Equal Pay Act 1970 and the Contracts of Employment Act 1972 and also the jurisdiction conferred on them by or under this Act.
