General

12 Financial provisions.

14 Short title, citation, interpretation, commencement and repeals.

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Social Security Benefits Act 1975.
- (2) This Act may be cited with the Supplementary Benefit Acts 1966 to 1973 as the Supplementary Benefit Acts 1966 to 1975, . . . F2
