ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT

Regulation of fisheries etc.

30 Introduction of fish into inland waters.

[^{F1}A person shall be guilty of an offence if he introduces any fish or spawn of fish into an inland water[^{F2}in Wales], or has in his possession any fish or spawn of fish intending to introduce it into an inland water[^{F2}in Wales], unless he first obtains the written [^{F3}consent of the appropriate agency or the inland water][^{F4}is one which consists exclusively of, or of part of, a fish farm and which, if it discharges into another inland water, does so only through a conduit constructed or adapted for the purpose.
