#### *Council chairman*

- 2 There shall be paid to the chairman of a Council such remuneration as the Secretary of State may determine; and in the case of a person remunerated under this paragraph there shall be no obligation to remunerate him also—
- (a) under paragraph 14 of Schedule 1 to the <sup>M1</sup>Hydro-Electric Development (Scotland) Act 1943, as a member of the North of Scotland Hydro-Electric Board or the South of Scotland Electricity Board; or
  - (b) under section 3(6) of the <sup>M2</sup>Electricity Act 1947, as a member of the Area Board for the same area as that for which he is chairman of the Consultative Council.]
