 - (a) a member may, at any time by not less than one month's notice in writing to his appointor, resign his office;
 - (b) the appointor of a member may declare the office of that member vacant on the ground that he is unfit to continue in his office; and
 - (c) if any member [F3 is the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order [F4 or an interim bankruptcy restrictions order, or a debt relief restrictions order or interim debt relief restrictions order under Schedule 4ZB of the Insolvency Act 1986]] or, in Scotland, if sequestration of a member's estate is awarded F5..., his office shall thereupon become vacant.
