### SCHEDULE 3

#### ARBITRATION

#### PART I

#### GENERAL

##### *Staff and expenses*

- 11 A tribunal may appoint such officers as they consider necessary for assisting them in the proper execution of their duties.
- 12 (1) There shall be paid to members of a tribunal such remuneration (whether by way of salaries or fees) and such allowances as the Secretary of State may, with the approval of [<sup>F1</sup>the Treasury], determine.
- (2) There shall be paid to any officer appointed under paragraph 11 above and any person to whom proceedings are referred by the tribunal under paragraph 27 below for inquiry and report such remuneration (whether by way of salary or fees) and such allowances as the tribunal may, with the approval of the Secretary of State given with the consent of [<sup>F1</sup>the Treasury], determine.
- (3) The Secretary of State shall pay such remuneration and allowances and any other expenses of a tribunal shall be defrayed by the Secretary of State out of money provided by Parliament.
